- Please do not cross exhibit barriers. Help us preserve our artifacts by enjoying exhibits from respectful distance unless otherwise indicated.
- Elevators/lifts are available to guests who need an alternative to the stairs.
- Sensory kits are available for guests to use while inside the museum.
- Trained service animals are allowed in the Museum and Exhibit Galleries. Other supervised and leashed animals are only allowed outside of the building.
- The museum is a substance-free environment; drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and vaping are not permitted.
- No firearms or weapons of any kind are permitted inside the museum
